30 competitors will qualify for Final III

After the second Final Competition, FEI World Cup points are transformed into penalties. The Athlete with the highest number of FEI World Cup points after two Competitions will have 0 penalties. For all other Athletes the number of penalties will be calculated by multiplying with the coefficient of 0.50 the difference between their number of World Cup points and the FEI World Cup points of the leading Athlete after two Competitions. In this procedure all decimals are rounded down.

Athletes with equality of penalties will retain the same starting order among themselves as in Final II.

This rule may cause that a competitor with less points (but same number of penalties) may start after one competitor with higher points.
